## **Direct Pay Federal Rebate or Tax Financing**


#### **Direct Pay**

- The Inflation Reduction Act is a climate and tax bill that was signed into law in August 2022
- Allows for 30% direct payments to nonprofits, cooperatives, schools and municipalities (30% of completed solar project costs)
- May require getting an approved loan if there is a cash shortfall




#### **Tax Financing Option**

- A Tax Sponsor finances a portion of the project in exchange for the right to claim tax incentives and depreciation reducing the lifetime cost of the project by 30% to 40%.
- Host site sees financial and environmental benefits of solar without the hurdle of a large up-front investment.




## Slice-of-Sun Bonds & Direct Pay Loan
